ROCK REFURBISHING FUND

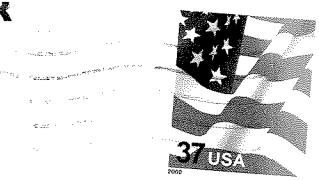
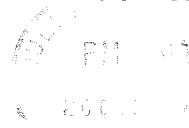
Cost for the rock refurbishing is sitting at \$24,837.23. That works out to just over \$191 per rock. So far the Rock Fund has received \$3,995.00

SMOKING ISSUE UPDATE - RANGE RECREATION CIVIC CENTER HAS SMOKING AREAS AGAIN

The RRCC Board reconsidered the smoking issue at its meeting last Wednesday, October 20, 2004. The RRCC Board unanimously voted to reestablish the smoking areas that had been designated when the building was opened.

The reason for the change back to both smoking and non-smoking areas was that because the RRCC is owned by the four cities, Eveleth, Gilbert, Mountain Iron and Virginia, the building does not fall under Eveleth's smoke-free ordinances for its public buildings.

The regulations that the RRCC falls under are contained in the Minnesota Indoor Clean Air Act, statute statute 144.413 et. Seq.

The RRCC Board designated the carpeted area on the second floor as a smoking area, the only area where smoking will be allowed.
